

How to shop with *easyfundraising* and *Give as you Live*


PCs, Macs, laptops using Donation Reminder

If you have downloaded and installed the **Donation Reminder** then you should see little icons like one of these (or both) up in the right corner of your browser window:

  The 'e' is for **easyfundraising** and the heart is for **Give as you Live**.

The **Donation Reminder** needs to be 'active' for it to work properly. If you click on the icon then it will indicate whether it is active or not.


For example, if you click on the icon and you see one of these appear:


then you need to login to your account to activate the **Donation Reminder**. Logging in will store a small cookie (a little file associated with and used by the handler's website) on your computer so that the **Donation Reminder** remains active in the background all the time. This means you don't need to log in each time you use this feature going forward unless, of course, you delete the cookie.

When the **Donation Reminder** is active then clicking on the icon will show something like the following:



Once you've logged in then you'll not need to worry about seeing if this feature is active all the time.

You have the choice of either (i) selecting the supplier's website from the list or search results displayed in the **Donation Reminder** or (ii) going directly to the supplier's website and letting the software do its own magic.



(i) Referring to the images at the top of this page, if you wanted to go to the John Lewis website, say, then clicking on the logo displayed will connect you to that website.

If your supplier is not displayed as a logo then you can start typing in its name in the search field. The example on the left shows a search for the website notinthehighstreet.com. Clicking on the result required will connect you to its website.

(ii) However, the whole purpose of the **Donation Reminder** is to allow you to go direct to your supplier's website without having to think about whether it is affiliated with the donation process or not and it'll do the checking for you.


Here's an example.

Suppose you wanted to book a short stay in a Travelodge. You may know the website's address already or you may use Google or another search engine to find the address. The results in Google, for example, will look something like this:




So, the **Donation Reminder** is also telling Google and you that Travelodge is an eligible website for donations via **easyfundraising**, in this particular case.

When you open the Travelodge website, either from your search engine or directly, the Donation Reminder will pop open a little window like one (or both) of the following. The blue one is for **Give as you Live**.



Whichever of these windows appears just click on the **Activate** or **Yes, Please** button to confirm you'd like the supplier to make a donation if you purchase anything from its website. Please note that if you are registered with both **easyfundraising** and **Give as you Live** then one process can be active at a time – you can't get double donations!




Clicking the activation sends a message to the website that the donation process is to be included in the website's handling of your purchases. It may result in the website refreshing its display on your screen but that is just part of the messaging.

Now you can go shopping as that's all there is to it. So, whenever you visit a website that is registered with the handler with which you have opened an account and downloaded the **Donation Reminder**, you will get prompted about whether you wish to invoke the donation process or not. For WCS' sake, please select yes!

If you would prefer not to download/install the automated **Donation Reminder** on your computer then you can still activate the donation process with your chosen supplier's website but by using a different method. See the next page.

Tablets, smartphones and PCs/Macs not using the Donation Reminder

Currently the software technology for mobile devices like tablets and smartphones cannot yet facilitate the **Donation Reminder** feature. Therefore, the way to initiate the donation process with your supplier's website is by accessing that website via the [easyfundraising](#) or [Give as you Live](#) website.



For tablets and smartphones there are equivalent apps available for downloading and installing on your device from both handlers that make it easier to use on these smaller devices. Both the handler's website and its app do the same thing so you can use either on your device. In all cases you will get re-directed to the supplier's website to continue your purchasing.



When you have logged in to the website or opened the app on your mobile device, you can search for your required supplier much in the same way as you can search within the **Donation Reminder** explained in the first section. By selecting the supplier you wish to visit, the [easyfundraising](#) or [Give as you Live](#) website will transfer you to that supplier website and include a request to the supplier to include the donation process after you have completed your purchase.

Now you can continue with your shopping as normal.

The difference between this method and the first one (with the **Donation Reminder**) is that you have to remember to use the [easyfundraising](#) or [Give as you Live](#) website or mobile app first in order to activate the donation process.

Please note: If you do not go through the [easyfundraising](#) or [Give as you Live](#) website or mobile app first then the donation process will not be invoked. This is especially true on a mobile device if you have also downloaded and use your supplier's own app. These apps do not contain any software coding to link to [easyfundraising](#) or [Give as you Live](#).

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In all cases, after you have completed your purchase, the handler will usually send you a confirmation email that the purchase has been successful and the donation will be made by the supplier. The donation can take up to 30 days to be 'credited' to your account. You can see a detailed list and summary of your donations via your account and the [easyfundraising](#) or [Give as you Live](#) website will transfer the accumulated donations to WCS automatically on a regular basis, typically every three months. They'll handle everything for you.
