


How to open an account with easyfundraising

- 1) Go to the [easyfundraising](http://www.easyfundraising.co.uk) website by using www.easyfundraising.co.uk.
- 2) Find the **Search for a cause** box – it should be on the home page – and start to type in “Wimbledon Choral”. You should see the choir’s name appear below your typing.



- 3) Click on the choir name and the following, or something similar, should appear:

- 5) If you do not already have an account with **easyfundraising** then you can choose to register by using either your Facebook ID (if you are a Facebook user) or your email address – most users will probably do the second one. Select the option you wish to use.

If you are happy to opt for using your Facebook ID then the process will seek your permission to link your **easyfundraising** account with your Facebook ID, which you will use when you log in on later occasions.

The process below follows the email option.

- 6) When you click on the **Continue with email** option the screen will change this:

- 7) Fill in your name, preferred email address (which will become your login User ID), your password, leave or untick the marketing option as you wish, tick the final box if you are OK with the Ts & Cs and Privacy Policy then click **Create my account**.
- 8) This will create your new account linked to WCS as the 'cause'.
- 9) The next step depends whether you are using (1) a PC or laptop, or (2) a mobile device like an iPad, other tablet or your mobile smartphone.

- 10) **easyfundraising** works by it telling the participant website through which you are purchasing the stuff you want (e.g. www.johnlewis.com) that you are registered with **easyfundraising** and that a donation from the retailer will be expected once you have completed your purchase on their website.

PCs and laptops

For users of PCs, Macs, laptops and so on, you have the option of installing a clever little piece of software that **easyfundraising** supplies that sits inside your web browser (Chrome, Firefox, Internet Explorer, Edge, Safari, etc) and checks to see if the supplier website you are visiting is registered with **easyfundraising** and so eligible for giving a donation. It is called the **Donation Reminder**. If you are registering on a PC, Mac or laptop then, at this point in the registration process, you should be offered the option of downloading and installing this software so that the checking process is automated for you. Please accept this opportunity to download it. It is safe to do so. When using your browser, the software should kick in automatically and inform the supplier website that you are an **easyfundraising** user. If you do not wish to download or install this feature then you do not have to do so.

Tablets and smartphones

Currently the software technology for mobile devices like tablets and smartphones cannot yet facilitate the **Donation Reminder** feature so you will not be offered this option at this point in the registration process.
