Handel's *Israel in Egypt* tells the dramatic story of the liberation of the Israelites from slavery in Egypt, including the arrival of Moses, the plagues and the escape across the Red Sea.

Filled with frogs, locusts, hailstones and rivers of blood, the plagues inspired Handel to create some of his most colourful word painting, often using a double chorus to tell the story.

In the second part of the oratorio Handel's exultant themes, as Israel celebrates its freedom, are evocative of the songs of victory of every age and culture.
