Will Todd's Mass in Blue

Will Todd's Mass in Blue, an upbeat setting of the latin mass, is a brilliant blend of driving jazz grooves and clear, strong, choral writing against which the solo piano and solo soprano voice weave and blend in a delightful aural tapestry. The work reflects not only the composer's love of jazz music and his admiration of jazz performers, but also his own experience as an improviser. It will guarantee to capture the audience's attention; the jazzy rhythms in the Kyrie and Credo are wonderfully complimented by the calmer and more reflective Sanctus.

The piece has rapidly established itself in the choral repertoire, and whilst it is far from traditional, it has universal appeal for classical music followers as well as for jazz enthusiasts. A superb meeting of two music genres, this will be a very special concert. It includes a jazz set by Will Todd and his band before the performance of the mass itself.

Please note the start time of 6pm; the concert will last approximately one hour and fifteen minutes allowing you to explore afterwards the South Bank, where there are numerous pubs, bars, cafés and restaurants, as well as benches for picnics overlooking the river on a lovely summer evening.
