Profoundly moving, Rachmaninov's *All-Night Vigil* has been described as "the greatest musical achievement of the Russian Orthodox Church". Written during the darkest hours of the First World War, at a time of great uncertainty in Europe, this masterpiece, with its deep religiosity, is underpinned by constantly inventive choral virtuosity.

Britten dedicated his *Cello Suites* to his great friend, the cellist Rostropovich. In the 3rd Suite, which takes centre stage in this programme, he pays tribute to Rostropovich's Russian homeland, with themes redolent of doleful folk songs and culminating in the Russian Hymn for the Departed, the Kontakion.

Widely considered one of the finest choruses in London, Wimbledon Choral Society is delighted to be returning to Southwark Cathedral for this specially devised programme by Richard Wilberforce. Interspersing selected movements from the *All-Night Vigil* and *Cello Suites Nos 1 & 3*, this concert promises to be a most powerful and unforgettable experience.
