Come and hear Wimbledon Choral, Florilegium and international soloists perform J.S. Bach's St. John Passion, under the baton of Neil Ferris!

In this second concert, the centre piece of Wimbledon Choral's Triptych of Passions, we present the oldest of the surviving Passions by Bach, first performed in 1724, at Good Friday Vespers in Leipzig. It is one of the great passions, epitomising most music-lovers' idea of passion music.

In this Triptych series we explore a number of different ways the story of the final days of Jesus Christ on earth are told in music. Bach's masterpiece contrasts with, but also finds echo in, the more modern interpretations of the passion performed in the first concert in November 2022 and the third concert to take place on 17 June 2023 at Southwark Cathedral.

The Cathedral is well served by a number of trains, buses, tube and boats. There is no car parking available at the Cathedral.

We recommend using the TFL Journey Planner to plan your visit if you are using the London Underground, buses, Docklands Light Railway (DLR) or the river buses and cruises.

By rail

- › London Bridge Station
– 5 minutes' walk
- › Cannon Street Station
– 10 minutes' walk
- › Blackfriars Station
– 15 minutes' walk

By London Underground

- › London Bridge Station (Jubilee and Northern Lines) – 5 minutes' walk
- › Monument (Circle & District Lines)
– 8 minutes' walk
- › Cannon Street Station (Circle & District Lines) – 10 minutes' walk
- › Bank Station (Northern & Central Lines) – 15 minutes' walk

By DLR

- › Bank Station (Northern & Central Lines) – 15 minutes' walk

By bus

- › Routes 17, 21, 35, 40, 43, 47, 48, 133, 141, 149, 344, RV1 all stop at London Bridge Station, London Bridge or Borough High Street.
