

Southwark Cathedral is situated less than five minutes walking distance from London Bridge station.

The Cathedral is well served by a number of trains, buses, tube and boats. There is no car parking available at the Cathedral.

We recommend using the TFL Journey Planner to plan your visit if you are using the London Underground, buses, Docklands Light Railway (DLR) or the river buses and cruises.

By rail

- > London Bridge Station
– 5 minutes' walk
- > Cannon Street Station
– 10 minutes' walk
- > Blackfriars Station
– 15 minutes' walk

By London Underground

- > London Bridge Station (Jubilee and Northern Lines) – 5 minutes' walk
- > Monument (Circle & District Lines) – 8 minutes' walk
- > Cannon Street Station (Circle & District Lines) – 10 minutes' walk
- > Bank Station (Northern & Central Lines) – 15 minutes' walk

By DLR

- > Bank Station (Northern & Central Lines) – 15 minutes' walk

By bus

- > Routes 17, 21, 35, 40, 43, 47, 48, 133, 141, 149, 344, RV1 all stop at London Bridge Station, London Bridge or Borough High Street.
