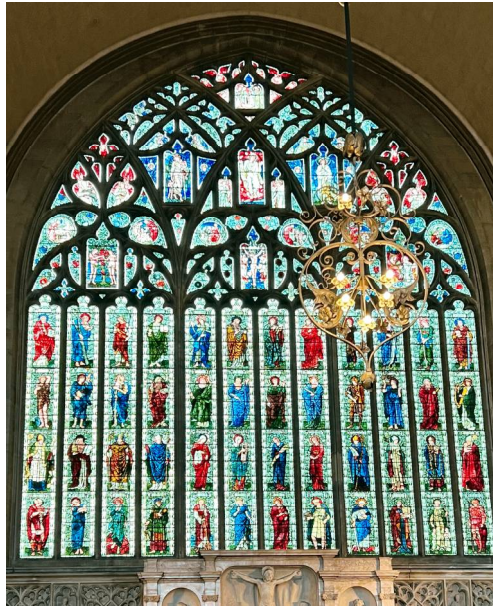


WIMBLEDON CHORAL

Here are the concert notes for our summer concert in Holy Trinity, Sloane Square this coming Saturday 29th June. If you have any questions, please speak to your voice rep.



Concert Week Rehearsal:

- THURSDAY 27th June: Trinity URC on Mansell Road (19.30 - 22.00)

Venue

HOLY TRINITY SLOANE SQUARE: SLOANE STREET, SW1X 9BZ (www.sloanechurch.org)

- Public Transport: The closest tube station is Sloane Square, on the District and Circle lines, and there are a number of bus routes. There are currently no planned engineering works on these two tube lines, but as ever, please check for updates on the TfL website, etc.

There are still roadworks on Sloane Square and Sloane Street. The entrance to the church is clear, but parking and bus stops may be affected.

Concert Day

Saturday Afternoon Rehearsal: 15:00 - 17:30 Please arrive between 14.30 and 14.45, and no later than 14.45. It is a prompt 15.00 rehearsal start.

Changing Rooms: We have access to the Kindergarten and the Parish Rooms for ladies and gents changing respectively. These spaces are not huge, so please come changed and ready if possible.

Please note - the Parish room will only be available from 5pm due to an art exhibition. The church has said that we can use the choir stalls for our bags and belongings until then, but please don't leave anything in the main body of the church.

- As usual, please don't bring more stuff than you need and please consider heading out between the rehearsal and the concert. There are restaurants nearby and Peter Jones is good for refreshments and toilets.
- Please no foods containing peanuts or sesame seeds as some children that use the kindergarten have severe allergies.

Concert dress:

- Either elegant, plain black full-length skirts or trousers, black long-or ¾ sleeved tops.
- Or black DJ trousers and jacket and black open neck shirts.
- Small black handbag if necessary and please, no perfume.
- Don't forget your black folder!

Concert: 7.30PM - 9PM

- Please be dressed and ready to go on stage by 7.15PM.
- Procession details to be confirmed at the rehearsal in the afternoon.
- Please don't take water bottles on stage for the concert, be alert to any invitations to stand and sit, and please resist waving at your friends.

Stands and Sits

- Stand as conductor and pianist walk on.
- Neil will sit us all down after every few pieces whilst he talks to the audience, so please be alert to any instructions.
- We will be seated for Michael's piano solo.
- At the end of the concert: Sit as the conductor and soloists go off stage. Stand when indicated by the conductor to receive applause. Applaud when seated, don't applaud when standing as you are receiving applause.

Please stay seated at the end of the concert because we are going to have a photo' taken of the choir.
