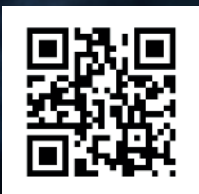

By Tube

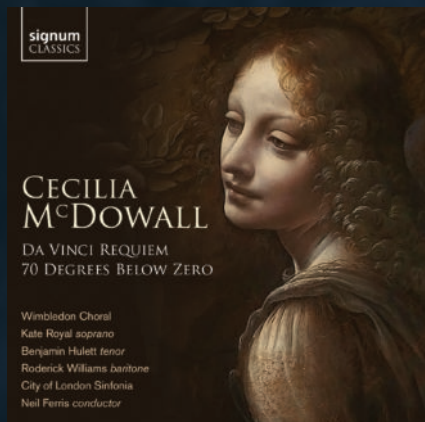
The following stations are within walking distance:
